## Hello Beloved Community of Aldersgate Church,

Wow, what a year it has been. The November 2019 campaign, "All Hands on Deck, All Resources In", was an effort to move us forward in our mission. Just a few months later COVID-19 wreaked havoc on



plans and operations for every industry in the country. The truth is, all across the nation, everything has changed. It's as though our foundations have been swiftly taken right our from under our feet. We've all faced our many and varied life changes and personal responses, but regardless of the manifestations and nuances, it's safe to say that it's been hard on everybody.

But here's the good news: God is moving.
