


**Happening This Week:** July 30 – August 5

### Call to Worship

#### ALL: The kingdom of God is here, and coming.

ONE: A mustard seed that someone took and sowed in his field; it is the smallest of all the seeds, but when it has grown it is the greatest of shrubs and becomes a tree, so that the birds of the air come and make nests in its branches.

ONE: Yeast that a woman took and mixed in with three measures of flour until all was leavened.
