The Story: New Life for Dry Bones

Have you ever been let down by a friend? They said they would do something and they forgot. They said they would meet you but they did not show up. This is what happened to Jesus. Peter said to Jesus that he would always be his friend but then when things got tough, Peter said he did not know Jesus. Even though he lied about knowing Jesus, Peter is forgiven. Later, Jesus said that Peter was the rock that the church would be built on. They stayed friends.

When Jesus was with his disciples in the upper room, he said to them: 'All of you will abandon me tonight.' Peter said: 'Not I! Even if all the others leave you, I will never leave you.' But Jesus told Peter: 'Before a rooster crows, you will say three times that you don't know me.'

Activity:

Messy (all ages)
