#### **Activities:**

# "Hosanna!" And Palms (any age):

You will need: green construction paper, <u>palm</u> <u>template</u> OR real palm branches.



Follow instructions to make palm branches. Or, using real palm branches, read the Retelling for Young People, Palm Sunday poem, waving branches. Discuss how it might have felt as the crowds welcomed Jesus that day with all the noise and shouting and palm waving. Discuss how they might have felt being part of the crowd that day welcoming Jesus and discuss how we welcome people today.

Jesus stumbling under the weight of wood.




Soldiers dividing clothes with the throw of a dice people braying insults far and wide, priests praying now their work is done.

# Paper Palm Leaf

Cut this template along the dotted line.

Fold a piece of green construction paper in half and paper clip the template so the dotted line is along the fold.

Cut through the template and both layers of construction paper along the black lines.

Discard the template (unless you want to make more leaves).

Unfold the construction paper to see your finished palm leaf.

Optional: Tape a green pipe cleaner or thin rolled tube of construction paper to the center as a stem.
